Bailey, a 68 pound, 2 year old, male, white, pure-breed yellow lab has won more than 13 Awards in competitions including multiple World Wide Events watched by over 2 million TV viewers. He is one of the very few large breed dogs that have done well in Disc Dog Events while excelling as one of the top canine competitors worldwide. He has most recently been invited to the Skyhoundz Disc Dog 2005 World Championships being held in Atlanta.

Youngest competitor. Recognized as favorite dog by ESPN sports caster who requested one of his Bailey’s puppies. Most asked question was who is his breeder because I want one. Flew to competition in airplane cabin as celebrity dog status. Baily was such a crowd pleaser passengers had to wait in lines to meet him.

 Competitors from as far away as Japan came to compete. It was very exciting for me and Bailey to make it to the final day of competition.

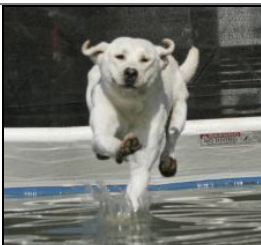
UFO Local Championship West Los Angeles, CA 2006
